Members Chat, A Corvette Story
As Told by Gregory Lucyk

I was 11 years old when I experienced my first ride in a Corvette. My 16 year old sister was dating a guy who drove a 1956 Corvette. He must have seen me admiring his car when he offered me a ride. I'll never forget that day. I remember so well the beautiful lines and shiny chrome, the distinctive sound of the engine with its two-four barrel carburetors, the whine of the transmission and the wind in my hair as we sped along the streets of St. Louis. I was mesmerized and told myself that one day I will have a Corvette just like this.

It took nearly 40 years but in November 2000 I finally brought home my first generation 1961 Corvette. It was Ermine White, with silver coves and a rare Jewel Blue interior. I had been searching the internet and found this one at Pro Team Corvette in Napoleon, Ohio. They were having a "white sale" - all their white Corvettes were discounted 10%! I caught a flight out of Dulles to Toledo, rented a car and drove to their showroom. I looked at six first-generation Corvettes, all of them white and all with black or red interiors, except this one with Jewel Blue. I had to have that car. I made a down payment, wired the balance and a week later a flatbed pulled up to my Richmond home to deliver my beautiful Corvette.

It's now 24 years and many upgrades later and I still have my C-1 Corvette. I've purchased other Corvettes since then, a '79 Arctic Blue coupe, a '93 40th Anniversary car, and a silver 2002 coupe (I was sometimes referred to in the neighborhood as "the guy with two Corvettes"), but my first love is and will always be that straight-axle C-1. When I turn the key and hear that naturally aspirated small-block Chevy engine roar into life it's like I'm 11 years old again - I still feel the same thrill and excitement that comes with owning and driving America's Sports Car!






